4. Jesus was born **to be the Savior of the world, in fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies.** Matthew 1:21
5. Jesus was born in **Bethlehem.** Matthew 2:1
6. Joseph and Mary name their baby 'Jesus' **at the command of God delivered through the angel Gabriel.** Matthew 1:21
